In more ancient times, alchemists sought to manipulate and alter the properties of matter. Like the mysterious practice of changing base metal to gold, this piece in essence concerns orchestral transformations.

Textures shift and change from one state to another: clarity to obscurity, density to spaciousness, movement to stillness. Melodies float in and out like threads of ink in water, collecting together to form startling masses of solid colour, and then dissipating into the ethereal smoke-like world generated by a pair of cymbals.



Strange Alchemy was written for the Melbourne Symphony Orchestra's Cybec 21st Century Australian Composers' Program, and subsequently selected for inclusion in the 2014 MSO Metropolis Festival program.
